



Submission Guidelines

The intent of Redress as a journal is to capture the issues of the time, celebrate the wins, and champion the rights of women and girls in education and society generally.

Redress welcomes contributions on all educational matters that are likely to interest women. This includes academic papers, reports on research, short articles, book reviews, letters to the editor, line drawings, cartoons and photographs. Some issues of Redress are thematic in nature. Others cover a wide range of issues relevant to women and girls. Many previous issues and articles are on AWE's website.

Submissions should include a brief biographical note (80 - 100 words) and a scanned photograph of the author. Photographs and images of suitable quality for print reproduction should be presented in .bmp or .jpeg format. Email is preferred for the submission of articles and graphic files.

An article can be from 800 to 3,000 words and it must be comprehensible to general readers. An academic paper should include a 200-word abstract. References in the text should appear as bracketed numbers only, with numbered references listed in full at the end of the article. There are to be no footnotes. All material is evaluated by the editors, and outside referees where appropriate. The editors reserve the right to edit copy accepted for publication.

Women actively involved in education as practitioners, administrators, academics or researchers, and women who have an interest in the education of women and girls are invited to forward material for publication.
